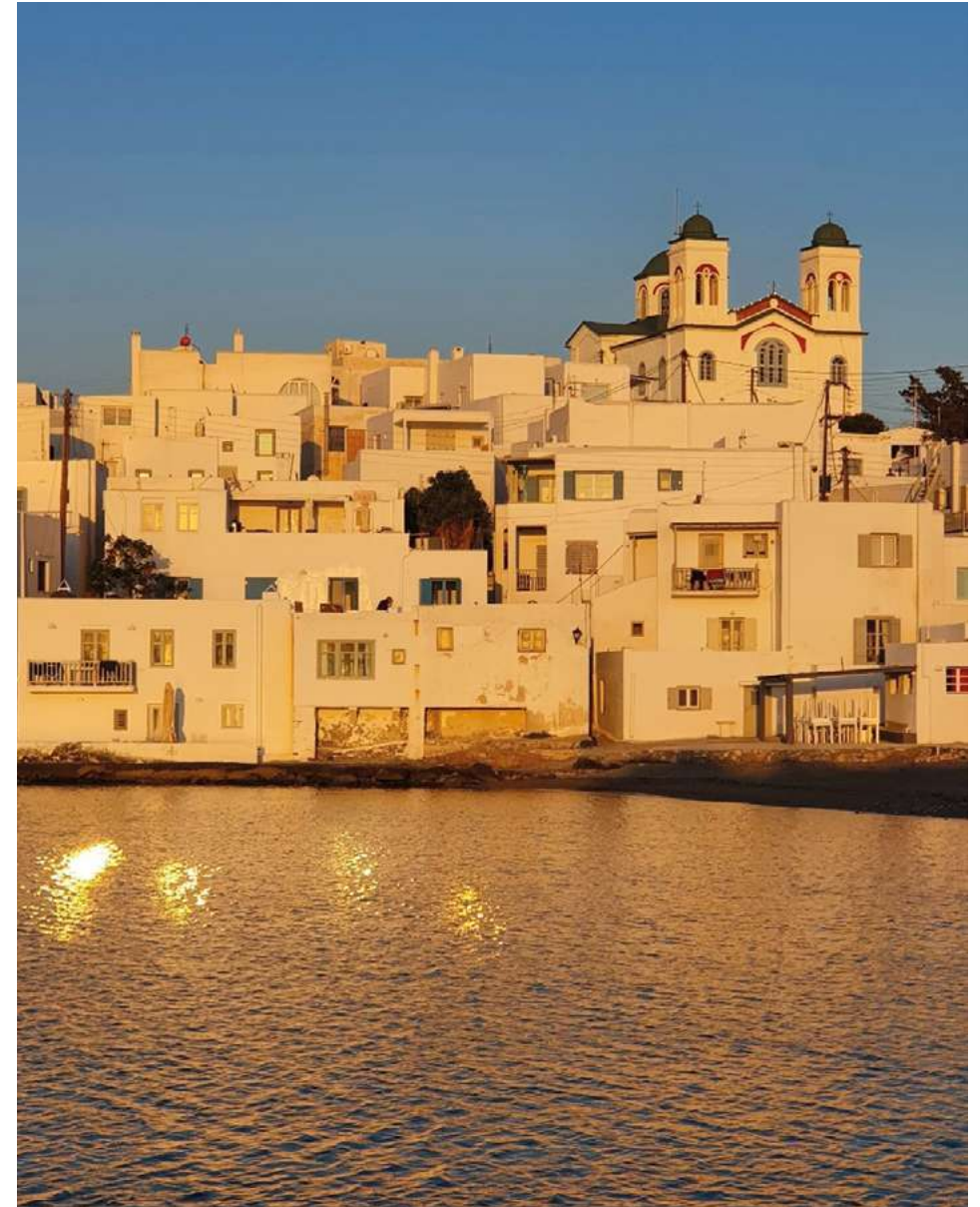
The island of Paros, rising out of the sea in the heart of the Cyclades, with its unrivaled natural landscapes and its golden beaches offers a unique holiday destination in Greece. Stay in one of our amazing Bright Blue Villas and start dreaming of a fascinating memorable vacation: the young crowds will love the water sports, the beach bars, and the nightclubs, and families with children will adore the safe sandy beaches with kids' activities and the romantic couples will get excited with the relaxing enchanting atmosphere.

The Parian traditional villages located in fertile plains, particularly Naousa, Parikia, and Lefkes, are perfect samples of the Cycladic architecture, with their whitewashed cubic houses, paved streets, and bright blue-domed churches. In Paroikia, the impressive church of Ekatontapylani is considered the oldest and most important Byzantine monument in Greece. It is believed that this church was built according to the orders of Saint Helena, the mother of Constantine the Great.

Have an early dinner in Naousa to capture the sunset's best colors. Once a fishing village in the north, it now boasts a chic island atmosphere with fabulous restaurants and bars on its waterfront. Stroll around the narrow streets and discover shops selling trendy Greek clothes, modern Greek jewelry, beachwear, and handcrafted sandals that are now sold in several stores and boutiques abroad.

VISIT ANTIPAROS

Last but not least, don't miss a day trip to Antiparos a smaller island opposite Paros, just a ferry ride away; its cobbled stone paved streets, the whitewashed alleys, the houses decorated with thriving pink and purple bougainvilleas attract each year a distinguished international crowd from Hollywood stars to fashion designers and royals.

BEACH LIFE

Paros beaches are famous for their turquoise waters and their golden sand. The beaches on the southeastern side, such as Golden Beach and New Golden Beach, are particularly popular for windsurfing and kitesurfing and have consistently been the venue for the Windsurfing World Championship.

Best Beaches for Families:

Faraggas Beach / Marcello Beach / Kolympithres / Santa Maria Beach

Faraggas Beach

A beautiful sandy beach on the southern side of the island. This beach has crystal clear water. The right side of the beach is not organized while on the left, you'll find a beach bar/restaurant with sunbeds & service by the beach.

Marcello Beach

Marcello beach is in Parikia bay only 4.1 km from the port. It's a long beach with white, soft sand and clear water. The access to the beach is easy by car and other ways of transportation. Alternatively, visitors can take a small fish boat from the port of Parikia to the beach. At Marcello you can relax at either of the 2 beach bars available along the beach. Suitable for families.

Kolympithres Beach

Kolympithres, one of the most famous beaches of Paros. It's located in the bay of Naousa. This beach is impressive because of the huge white blocks of granite, sculpted into strange smooth shapes. The water is warm and blue and the view of Naousa village is spectacular. The beach gets crowded, so we recommend going early in the morning to secure a spot. A whole day can be spent on this beach as there are bars and taverns.

Tip Kolympithres beach is protected from the winds and is highly recommended for the days with strong northern and southern winds.

Santa Maria Beach

Santa Maria, a famous beach on the island located on the north side and it is split into two parts. It has white sand and turquoise water. It is the perfect spot for snorkeling as there is a small sports center. The one side is organized, with sunbeds and a restaurant available for the visitors' convenience. Santa Maria, Laggeri, and Small Santa Maria are three beaches on the same direction making it easy to visit all three of them within a day. Santa Maria is not recommended those days with strong north winds.

Parasporos is found south of Parikia, the capital of Paros. It is a large sandy beach. There are some beach bars and a tavern available. Also, some of the best beach parties are hosted there. This beach is more enjoyable the days with less wind.

Best Beaches for Watersports:

Golden Beach / Monastiri Beach / Pounda Beach

Golden Beach

Golden beach is located on the southeast part of the island, well known for the water sports center and the long distance of soft, golden, sand that covers 700 meters.

An ideal spot for windsurfing and kitesurf lovers but also for families as the water is shallow. There are several beach bars and tavernas as well as umbrellas along the beach.

Monastiri Beach

Monastiri, is one of the most beautiful beaches on the island. It's located in Naousa Bay 8 km away from Naousa village and 13 km away from Parikia which is the capital of Paros. The location of this beach is unique as it is found on the northwest entrance of the bay. The terrain consists of thick sand and the water is crystal clear. Besides the bar, there is also a watersports center for visitors to enjoy.

Pounda Beach

Pounda beach is found on the South coast, close to Marpissa. It attracts fans of sailing, divers, surfers, extreme sports fans, and other active tourists. The beach bar is known for the parties and other events arranged. The beach bar offers Greek and continental cuisine.

Hidden Gems / Less crowded:

Lolantonis beach / Agia Irini / Tripiti & Glyfa / Laggeri Beach / Molos Kalogeros / Piso Alik

Lolantonis Beach

Lolantonis is a sandy beach suitable for families and younger crowds. In this beach you'll find a famous beach bar-restaurant, "The cliff", where guests can enjoy outstanding Mediterranean food.

Agia Irini

A small and dreamy beach with a tropical atmosphere as it has many tall palm trees and clear turquoise waters. There are 2 beach bars and a tavern. On the right, up the hill, you'll find the monastery of Saint Irini. This beach is highly recommended for families although in the summer season it is usually crowded.

Tripiti & Glyfa

Glyfa beach during high season, has a small beach bar for refreshments and cocktails. Tripiti is a small bay on the southern side of Paros next to Glyfa beach. Tripiti and Glyfa are located a few minutes away from Drios village. Both beaches are not as popular, and they remain mostly quiet. Tripiti is unorganized with sand and rocks.

Laggeri Beach

Laggeri is the perfect place to relax and enjoy the sun.

It doesn't have easy access, due to the dirt road leading to the beach which makes it less crowded.

However, it is a lovely sandy beach that attracts several nudists. Santa Maria, Laggeri, and Mikri Santa Maria (small Santa Maria) are three beaches in the same part of the island and it's useful to list together and perhaps visit them within the same day.

Molos-Kalogeros Beach

Molos is a long, shallow, sandy beach with blue water. Molos is located after the village of Marmara. There are no sea-trees for shadow and there is no beach bar or tavern available, so you must be well prepared.

After a short walk, you will find the amazing beach of Kalogeros. This small beach is rocky and sandy also, facing Naxos Island. The shore is a mix of sand and pebbles, but the water is always clear.

Piso Alikí Beach

Alikí beach is one of the most adorable beaches. This beach lays with many sea trees for natural shadow. The water is exotic, so clear and blue with white sand. This beach is very popular, attracting locals & visitors.

In the summer, it becomes crowded, but it is worth visiting. It has easy access, and it is surrounded by several restaurants. Also, you will not be troubled to find parking as in front of the beach, there is a huge parking area.

WINDSURFING AND KITESURFING

Also, windmills, watermills, wheel wells, wells, cisterns, threshing floors, and pigeon houses.

Some paths are organized and well-marked, others are old and exciting, and some are ideal for adventure lovers. The hiking trails of Paros are a real revelation, even for skeptics.

ALKIONI WILDLIFE PARK

Alkioni is a non-profit Wildlife Care and Protection Association, that aims to treat wounded, weak, or sick Wild Animals, which are hospitalized in the association's premises. Several animals are received each year and the whole operation of the park is based on voluntary work.

BUTTERFLY NATURE RESERVE

A butterfly valley or "Petaloudes" in Greek, is situated 7 km west of Parikia. An idyllic landscape of dense vegetation and abundant spring water. During the months of June to September, swarms of butterflies named *Euplagia quadripunctaria*, or Jersey tiger moth, settle on this small oasis.

They choose this place to spend the last phase of their life. Resting on the leaves, they can be observed by the guests in their natural habitat. If you are lucky, you might catch them while flying, revealing the vivid red of the underside of their wings, which contrasts with their dark upper side.

FOOD AND DINING

When speaking about food & dining on Paros Island, the choices are limitless and offer diverse cuisine options. Visitors will have the opportunity to explore, Greek traditional food at the local tavernas and gourmet Mediterranean options, as well as many different cuisines from around the world.

Barbarossa (+3022840 31951) in Naousa.

With a long tradition of serving tasty Greek food since the 60s, this restaurant has become a reputed eatery in the most picturesque point of Naoua, offering an authentic Greek gastronomic experience. Try the specialties such as appetizers of cockles, seashells, and oysters; stuffed ravioli with lobster; salmon in ouzo sauce and shrimp. This place is very famous for its daily party with Greek music.

Stilvi Restaurant (+30 694 621 1828) in Naousa.

Around the little streets of Naousa, there is a small oasis that will impress you! Stilvi Restaurant welcomes you in its atmospheric courtyard and offers special choices for your dinner by a signature Chef. The menu is based on Mediterranean cuisine with a modern twist, appealing to all tastes! The special cocktail list turns dining into a real experience.

Sigi Ikthios (+22840 52639) in Naousa.

In the picturesque port of Naousa, next to the fishing boats and all the island action, Yiannis and his team offer mouthwatering Greek delicacies and fresh fish. Seafood is the main option here, go for the grilled fish but we could not resist all the appetizers, most of them made with local produce.

Kapari (+30 22840 52070) in Naousa.

Their menu consists of inherited island dishes from treasured family recipes, shared by three generations and inspired by a childhood memory. Kapari restaurant (Caper in English) captures authentic flavors of the region, by gathering local ingredients, hand-picked from the incredibly rich, fertile region of the Cyclades.

Nobu "Matsuhisa" (+30 697 098 5411). Close to Naousa.

Avant Mar is pleased to welcome the acclaimed chef Nobu Matsuhisa to Paros. Located just steps away from Naousa, Matsuhisa Paros invites its guests to savor the finest cuisine, while enjoying the idyllic surroundings and relishing the cosmopolitan ambience.

Siparos Seaside Restaurant (+30 698 900 6325) in Santa Maria.

Siparos serves the culture and flavor of Paros with a creative, contemporary twist. The chefs have blended authentic Mediterranean tastes from local ingredients to make own-label products and traditional dishes, reimagined for the modern diner.

Blue Oyster (+30 22840 52707) in Ambelas.

It is a unique oyster bar a few kilometers away from Naousa. It's located by the sea, and it is an ideal place to relax and enjoy avoiding the busy town. At Blue Oyster Bar you will find a variety of fish, delicious starters, Mediterranean dishes, and fresh oysters.

Halaris Fish Tavern (+30 22840 43257). Piso Livadi.
Right on the dock of Piso Livadi, Halaris is one of the best tavernas on Paros, specializing in fresh fish and seafood dishes. Try the cod croquettes, shrimp pies, and the small fried fish -catch of the day! Don't leave without tasting the tomato croquettes! Recommended for families with children as the restaurant sits on a pedestrian street right on the waterfront.

Mango Restaurant (+30 22840 41462) in Logaras.
In case you need a break from Greek cuisine, Mango Restaurant is a great place to visit and enjoy freshly made pizza and pasta. At Mango you won't find only the classic recipes of Pizza but also signature recipes of pasta and risotto. The best time to visit is for an early dinner as the balcony offers a breathtaking view of Logaras golf.

Kima Seaside Restaurant (+30 22840 41180) in Drios.
A modern restaurant at the beach of Drios. It is open for breakfast or brunch and continues with delicious choices for lunch and dinner. Kima restaurant supports our local producers and utilizes the best raw material on Paros.

Thalassa mou (+30 22840 91461) in Aliko.
On the breaking wave, on the edge a picturesque village, this hidden gem serves creative Mediterranean dishes by using many local flavors and ingredients. A very good wine list adds more points to this must visit gourmet island spot by Chef Mario and this team. We simply love it.

Mario by the sea (+30 22840 51047) in Parikia.

Our favorite dinner spot in Naousa has moved to Parikia! Mario's serves fresh fish with a spin. Starters include tuna carpaccio with aromatic oil and smoked salt and grilled octopus with bucovo and caper sauce; even more exciting entrées like seafood pasta with diced asparagus and saffron, or fresh fish baked in a salt crust.

Mouragio (+30 22840 91165) in Aliko.

Mouragio is a must-visit ouzeri. A traditional, fish tavern, in Paros offering Greek delicacies. They have plenty of dishes specializing in seafood and fresh fish. You must try the plate "gouna" which is a sundried grilled fish, a local dish you can find only in Paros and Naxos islands.

Sayini (+30 22840 90536) in Aliko.

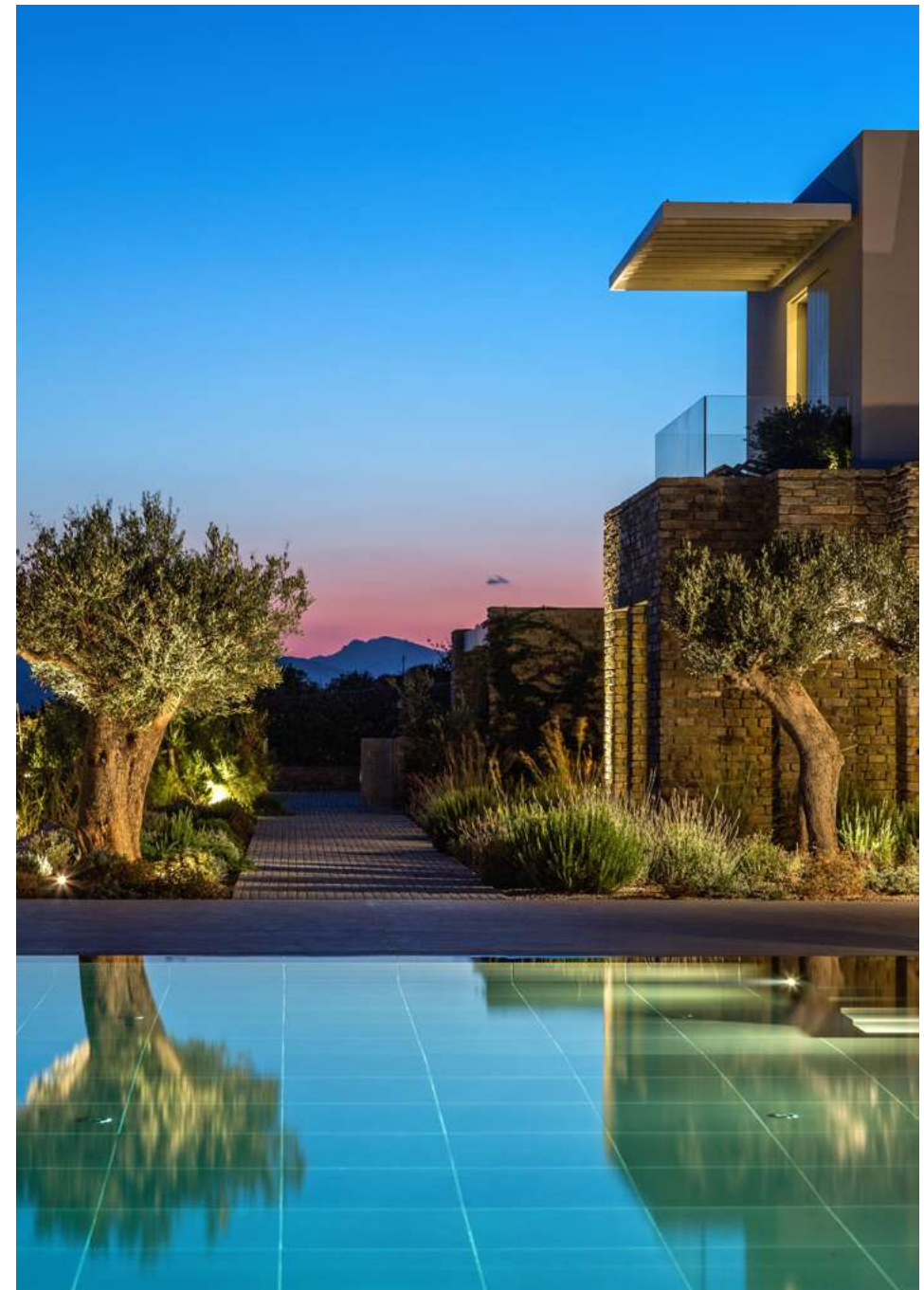

The Restaurant is famous for its impressive selection of high-quality wines, carefully curated from some of the best wineries in Greece.

Magaya (+22840 23791) in Parasporos.

Enjoy the Mediterranean flavor and a variety of Asian dishes in a boho and relaxed restaurant while viewing the emerald sea. Lounge to world music at one of the nicest beach bar restaurants in Paros.

GETTING THERE

By plane

Paros is connected by daily flights from Athens by Aegean Airlines (<https://en.aegeanair.com/>). Flight reservations well in advance are highly recommended, especially in the summer months. Sky Express (<https://www.skyexpress.gr/en>) also offers flights from Athens during the summer months. Flight time is approximately 40 minutes.

By ferry

Paros can be easily reached from the two Athens ports (Piraeus and Rafina), especially in the summer when ferry companies add to their scheduled journeys; Modern high-speed catamarans offering several classes of service € are operated by Hellenic Seaways (www.hellenicseaways.gr) also Sea Jets (www.seajets.gr) and are twice as fast if you wish to travel by boat. The trip lasts a little less than 4hrs.

You can also reach Paros via other Greek islands if you want to island-hop. Mykonos to Paros ferry ride varies from 30 minutes to 1 hour € 20 minutes. Naxos is an hour away. From Santorini to Paros travel time may vary from 1 hour and 25 minutes to 3 hours and 45 minutes depending on the vessel and weather conditions.

By helicopter

The helicopter ride from Athens to Paros lasts around 40 minutes and makes the island easily accessible to the most demanding travelers.

From Athens: Approximately 40 minutes

From Santorini: Approximately 25 minutes

From Mykonos: Approximately 20 minutes

Captain Pipinos (+30 22840 21823) at Saint George, Antiparos. In a beautiful and peaceful setting by the sea, where all dishes are cooked with special local ingredients and seafood is always fresh.

Lollo's (+30 22840 61215), town of Antiparos. Come here for amazing wood-fired pizzas, just on the port's waterfront, kids' favorite!

Samano (+30 698 853 3883) in Antiparos. Samano is a refined gastro restaurant by the Greek famous chef Leonidas Koutsopoulos. Taste pure, authentic dishes made with the finest Greek produce, or try creative cocktails and local wines while soaking up the sun in a modern environment.

Sunset bar (+30 698 173 1367) close to the town of Antiparos. A relaxed atmosphere with great cocktails and dishes. The sunsets are breathtaking, from its ideal location. It is recommended to make a reservation during the busy summer months.

Vassilenas Blue (+30 22840 63250), town of Antiparos. Vassilenas Blue brings to Antiparos the same prize-winning tastes and the hospitality tradition of the most historic Greek restaurant Vassilenas in Athens, which was established in 1920. It's located away from the big crowds and this restaurant is sharing modern Greek cuisine and a true love for fish, seafood, Greek wine, and relaxed hospitality.

GETTING THERE

By plane

Fly from Athens to Paros via Aegean Airlines (<https://en.aegeanair.com/>) and then take a 10 min ferry to Antiparos.

By ferry

Antiparos can be reached only by the small ferry that leaves from Pounta and arrives at the main port of Paros which is connected to most Cycladic islands and Athens' two ports (Piraeus and Rafina); Modern high-speed catamarans offering several classes of service are operated by Hellenic Seaways (www.hellenicseaways.gr) and Sea Jets (www.seajets.gr) and are twice as fast if you wish to travel by boat.

By helicopter

Just a 40 min helicopter ride from Athens – easily accessible even for the most demanding travelers.
From Mykonos to Antiparos is approximately 25 minutes ride.
From Santorini to Antiparos is approximately 30 minutes ride.

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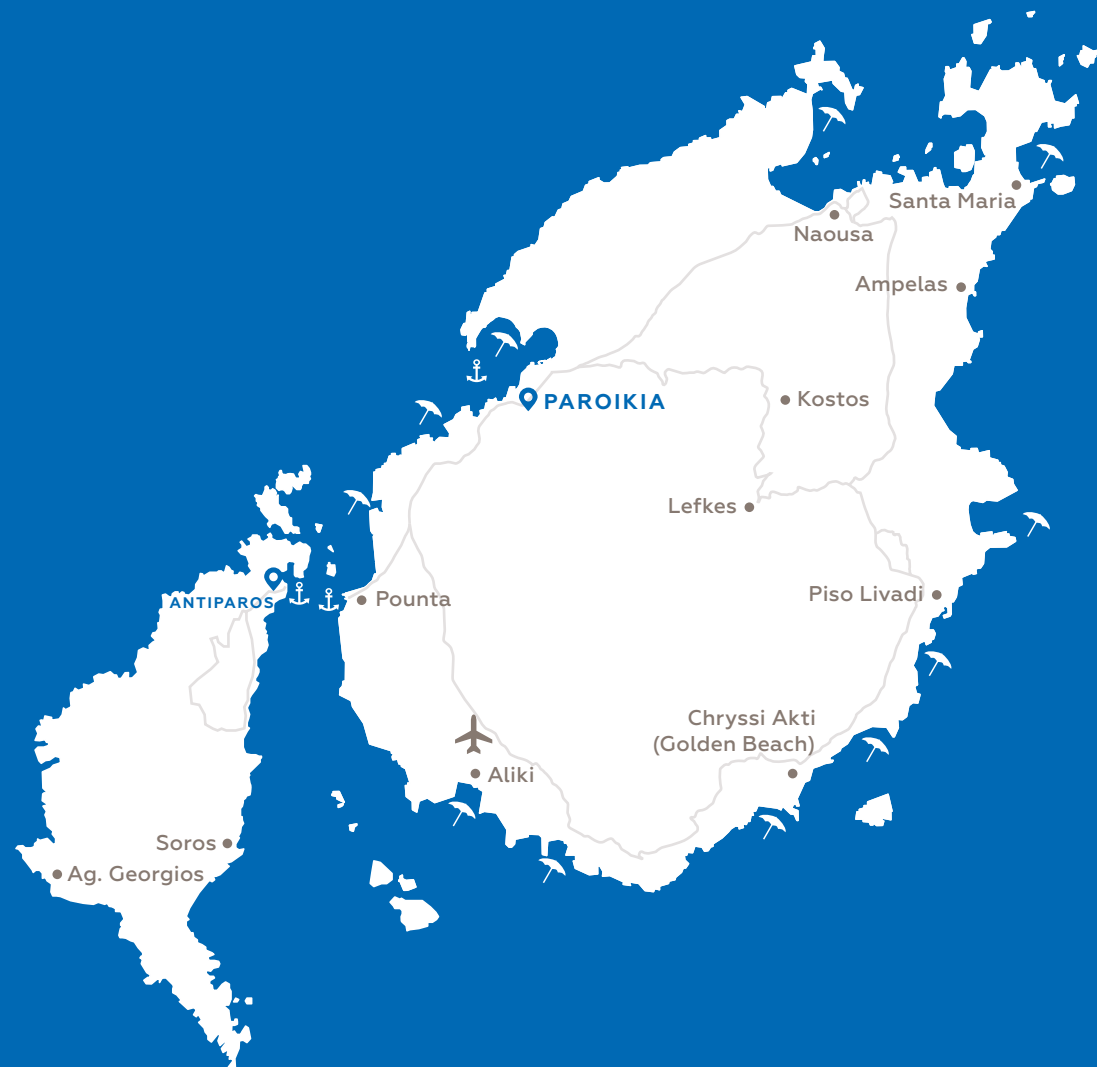
